Check List

- Seat Belts** • Belts and shoulder harnesses, securely mounted metal to metal, in good condition, in both front seats, at proper tension.
- Safety Harness** • If your car is equipped with harnesses they must comply with the PCA's regulation for proper mounting to the car and proper routing through **an approved race seat**, with cut outs for shoulder belts, lap belts and anti-sub belt. **Safety harnesses are not permitted with stock seats, without proper cut-outs for the belts. It must be an approved system.** If you have questions, please ask us about your situation.
- Equal Restraint** • A system (harnesses or belts) must be provided for both seats. If equal restraint is not available for the instructor the driver must use the same restraint available to the instructor. **The driver can not use a full harness system unless the same system is available to the instructor, otherwise both must use the stock seat belts.**
- Brake Fluid** • **Very Important**, brakes must be recently bled, topped off and fluid fresh. Brake fluid must be changed at least annually.
- Brake Pads** • Recommended at least 50% and rotors in good condition with no excessive cracks front or back.
- Pedals** • In good condition with proper return for both brake and throttle.
- Compartments** • Remove **all** loose items from trunk, glove box and car interior. This includes floor mats, phones, radar detectors, cups, mugs, papers, coins and all other loose items.
- Steering** • No excessive play in the wheel.
- Mirror** • At least one, securely mounted.
- Roll Bar / Roll Over Protection** • Mandatory for all open cars. Convertibles must pass the "broomstick test".
- Battery** • Securely held in place and in good condition. The positive terminal must be covered.
- Fluids** • No leakage of any fluid; gas, oil, brake fluid, coolant, power steering.
- Glass** • No cracks, windshield wipers and blades must be in good condition and the rear window unobstructed.
- Caps** • This includes the gas, oil, battery, power steering, brake and radiator caps or covers. All are to be tightened properly.
- Wheel Bearings** • Properly adjusted.
- Tires** • In good condition, no dry rot, proper inflation and tread depth for track conditions.
- Lug Nuts** • Torqued to the manufacturer's recommendation (95 ft. lbs. for Porsche cars).
- Wheel Covers** • Removed.
- Brake Lights** • Functioning properly.
- Helmets** • Must carry a Snell M or SA 2005 or newer sticker. **DOT approved motorcycle helmets are NOT acceptable.**
